



Past Progressive (Past Continuous) Tense

Note: One use of the past progressive tense is to describe an action that was happening (in progress) at a particular point in time in the past.

Past Progressive Tense and Simple Past Tense

Note: The past progressive tense is used to describe an action that was in progress when another action took place.

He was driving to work when he saw the accident.
